Course Details - What will the course consist of and how will it be delivered?

The Course provides opportunity for students with passion for art and design, fashion, style and creativity to undertake theme-based assignments and produce fashion or textile products. It is a highly practical course using a range of surface decorative techniques on textile as a media to produce a textile outcome.

At the end of the course students will be assessed on 60% coursework. There is an externally set final assignment with practical element which accounts for 40% of the final grade.

- Enjoyment of practical and vocational skills activities.
- Interested in following a career in Art and Design.

Further progression on completion of the course—what opportunities could this course lead towards in the future?

- Student may go on to study AS/A2 in Fashion and Textile Design.

- Direct entry into employment in the Fashion and Textiles / Art and Design Industry
- Progress to many Art and Design based courses / apprenticeship schemes
